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Michigan State Fair Homebrew Competition Terms & Conditions

1. By entering exhibits at the Michigan State Fair, you agree to the Michigan State Fair's General Terms and Conditions & Rules and Regulations. It is YOUR responsibility to read and understand all the terms and conditions, which can be found within this guidebook.
2. Qualifications: Any homebrewer with their legal residence within the State of Michigan can enter the Michigan State Fair Homebrew competition. No professional breweries or professional brewers will be allowed to enter this year of the competition.
3. Disputes: Should any dispute arise, the Michigan State Fair reserves the right to determine the proper resolution
4. Judging: Entries into the Michigan State Fair Homebrew Competition will be judged according to the 2015 BJCP style guidelines found at:

5. **The Michigan State Fair reserves the right to modify categories and/or subcategories to create a flight for judging and prize purposes.**
6. Parking: Parking for the awards ceremony/Friday Night Flights Beer Festival is available on-site at the Suburban Collection Showplace and is Free **if you show a copy of your registration confirmation.**

5 entry maximum per brewer

1. All entries must be made in accordance with the terms and conditions described herein.
2. The 2020 Michigan State Fair Homebrew Competition is limited to the first 300 entries total.
3. **Online Entry: To enter the Michigan State Homebrew Competition, please go to <https://reggiebeer.com/ReggieEntry.php?CompetitionID=OPUBSW1000553> and enter online. Each exhibitor is required to pay the entry fee(s) online at the time of entry. An exhibitor will not be considered entered into the Competition until payment is made in full and the entry is received by the Michigan State Fair. Payment can be made online with a valid credit card, debit card, or other valid form of online payment listed on the registration site.**

5. No entries will be accepted after July 1, 2020 or sooner if the cap of 300 entries is reached. To ensure participation, do not wait until the last minute to register.
6. Entry Fee is 5.00 per beer entry (3 – 12 oz. bottles per entry)

7. Entries will be accepted for all BJCP categories; however, the Michigan State Fair reserves the right to organize the categories it may accept to facilitate judging, based on availability of judges, and flight the categories for prize purposes.
8. Do not submit more than one entry per subcategory. Example: it is not acceptable to enter two American Amber Ales, but it IS acceptable to enter one American Amber Ale and one American Brown Ale, since these are in different subcategories of the Other American Ale Category.

Beer Delivery Procedure

1. Beer will be accepted by the Competition **beginning July 3, 2020**. All beer must be received by the Competition **no later than July 17, 2020**. Ship or drop off entries (Monday to Friday 9am-5pm) to the address below:

2. Registration Forms and Bottle ID labels will be available at the competition website on Reggie Beer. Please print these documents and include them with your entry submission. Please attach the appropriate label to each bottle securely with a rubber band.

Competition Information

1. Entries may not be submitted that have been brewed on equipment used for any commercial purpose, including research, production, or brew on premise establishments.
2. Assistant brewers of award-winning beers will be announced and listed in the official results, but prizes will be presented only to the primary brewer.
3. Entries must receive a minimum judge score of 30 to be eligible for an award. First, Second, and Third, places will be awarded to the top three eligible entries in each category. The first-place winner in each category will advance to the "Best of Show" round.
4. Each entry must consist of three (3) bottles, 12 ounces in volume, brown or green glass. The Competition strives to ensure that all entries can be judged anonymously to ensure the integrity of blind judging. Entries must be completely free of paper labels (besides Bottle ID labels) and/or inked brand name lettering. Brewers are encouraged to use plain gold or silver caps. Obliterate any lettering or graphics on the cap with a permanent marker. Remove any other markings on the bottle or cap which may allow the entrant to be identified. Bottles with Grolsch-type swing tops are not allowed. Bottles with raised glass logos of common breweries (Sam Adams, dogfish head, etc.) are acceptable but any raised or engraved lettering or graphics identifying the entrant are not allowed. Bottles that do not meet these requirements, or cannot be judged

anonymously for any other reason, will be disqualified and will not be judged. There will be no refund of entry fees or additional purchased items.

5. This being the first occurrence of the new Michigan State Fair Homebrew Competition, the Competition is limited to the first 300 entries. Additionally, to accommodate judging, entry categories may be limited. Competition reserves the right to alter these limits.
6. Winners will be notified following judging which is scheduled to be completed Sunday July 14th).
7. Awards will be presented at the Michigan State Fair inside the beer tent (each brewer will receive two complimentary beers).
8. **Each brewer will receive one (1) ticket for admission (FAIR ONLY) into the Michigan State Fair. Additional tickets to the Fair may be purchased online at MichiganStateFairLLC.com. Beer Sample tickets may be purchased inside the beer tent.**

AWARDS

Awards to be presented Friday Sept. 4th at the Michigan State Fair beer tent

1. Best of Show – Trophy + Ribbon awarded to Best of Show. Best of Show recipient gets to brew their beer on a commercial system.
2. 2nd Place B.O.S. - State Fair Ribbon + Sponsored Prize
3. 3rd Place B.O.S. - State Fair Ribbon+ sponsored prize
4. “State Fair Beer” Subcategory – State Fair Ribbon + Annual Pass to Suburban Collection Showplace + Sponsored Prize
5. Ribbons provided to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, in each Category
6. We reserve the right to combine categories or sub categories as necessary for the purposes of awarding prizes. All entries will be judged against the guidelines for the sub category originally entered. Additional and specific prizes to be announced as sponsors are announced.
